RESOLUTION NO. 63

Series of 2020 August 14, 2020

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, to prevent the sharp rise of COVID-19 cases in the country, the President placed the entirety of Luzon under Enhanced Community Quarantine until April 14, 2020;

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2020, to develop a science-based approach in determining the risk-based classification of areas in the country, the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) convened a sub-Technical Working Group tasked to develop the LGU Epidemic Response Framework and to define parameters in assessing recent developments in the Philippine COVID-19 situation;

WHEREAS, on April 3, 2020, the IATF finalized the parameters for deciding on the lifting or extension of the Enhanced Community Quarantine in Luzon, which include trends on the COVID-19 epidemiological curve, the health capacity of the country, social factors, economic factors, and security factors;

WHEREAS, on April 30, 2020, the Office of the Executive Secretary issued Executive Order (E.O.) No. 112 Imposing an Enhanced Community Quarantine in High-Risk Geographic Areas of the Philippines and a General Community Quarantine in the Rest of The Country from 01 To 15 May 2020, Adopting The Omnibus Guidelines On The Implementation Thereof, And For Other Purposes;

WHEREAS, on May 27, 2020, the IATF released an updated risk classification in all Provinces, Highly Urbanized Cities and Independent Component Cities in the country, placing localities under different classifications of community quarantine with the goal of balancing economic activity and public health;

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2020, the Office of the President issued a Memorandum from the Executive Secretary placing Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine over the National Capital Region, and the provinces of Laguna, Cavite, Rizal, and Bulacan until August 18, 2020.

WHEREAS, on August 14, 2020, there is a recorded Six Thousand Two Hundred Sixteen new COVID-19 cases in the Philippines;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the IATF approves the recommendations of the IATF Screening and Validation Committee, as amended. Beginning 16 August 2020, the community quarantine classification of Provinces, Highly Urbanized Cities (HUCs), and Independent Component Cities (ICCs) based on epidemic risk level, economic, social, and security considerations, and the appeals and commitment of local government units (LGUs) shall be adopted:



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1. The following provinces, HUCs, and ICCs shall be placed under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) until 31 August 2020:

a. For Luzon:

- i. Cordillera Administrative Region Abra*, Apayao*, Ifugao*, Benguet*, Kalinga*, Mountain Province*, Baguio City*;
- ii. Region I Ilocos Norte*, Ilocos Sur*, La Union*, Pangasinan*, Dagupan City*;
- iii. Region II Batanes, Cagayan*, Isabela*, Nueva Vizcaya*, Quirino, Santiago City*;
- iv. Region III Aurora*, Bataan*, Pampanga*, Tarlac*, Zambales, Angeles City*, Olongapo City*;
- v. Lucena City;
- vi. Region IV-B Marinduque, Occidental Mindoro*, Oriental Mindoro*, Romblon, Palawan*, Puerto Princesa City*; and
- vii. Region V Albay*, Camarines Norte*, Camarines Sur, Catanduanes, Masbate*, Sorsogon, Naga City*.

b. For Visayas:

- i. Region VI Aklan*, Antique*, Bacolod City*, Capiz*, Guimaras*, Iloilo*, Negros Occidental*;
- ii. Region VII Bohol*, Cebu*, Negros Oriental*, Siquijor*; and
- iii. Region VIII Biliran*, Leyte*, Southern Leyte*, Eastern Samar, Northern Samar, Western Samar*, Ormoc City*, Tacloban City*.

c. For Mindanao:

- i. Region IX Zamboanga del Norte*, Zamboanga del Sur*, Zamboanga Sibugay*, Zamboanga City;
- ii. Region X Bukidnon*, Camiguin*, Lanao del Norte*, Iligan City*, Misamis Occidental*, Misamis Oriental*, Cagayan de Oro City*;
- iii. Region XI Davao de Oro*, Davao del Norte*, Davao del Sur*, Davao Occidental*, Davao Oriental*, Davao City*;
- iv. Region XII North Cotabato*, South Cotabato*, Sarangani*, Sultan Kudarat*, General Santos City*, Cotabato City*;
- v. Region XIII (Caraga) Agusan del Norte*, Agusan del Sur, Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Norte*, Surigao del Sur, Butuan City*; and
- vi. Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) Basilan*, Lanao del Sur*, Maguindanao*, Sulu, Tawi-Tawi.

2. The following provinces, HUCs, and ICCs shall be placed under General Community Quarantine (GCQ) until 31August 2020:

^{*}NTF and DILG shall ensure localized actions are implemented



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- a. For Luzon:
 - i. Nueva Ecija*; and
 - ii. Region IV-A Batangas, Quezon.
- b. For Visayas:
 - i. Iloilo City; and
 - ii. Region VII Cebu City, Lapu-Lapu City, Mandaue City.
- 3. In the case of Cebu, the province shall be placed under MGCQ, except for the City of Talisay and the Municipalities of Minglanilla and Consolacion, which shall remain under GCQ, with strict enforcement of indicated local actions, to be monitored by the NTF;
- 4. All provinces, HUCs, and ICCs are directed to observe the strict enforcement of the following measures:
 - a. Minimum public health standards, especially uniform implementation in high-risk areas such as healthcare settings, wet markets, supermarkets, government offices, and workplaces, among others;
 - b. Localized community quarantine and availability of identified quarantine facilities in priority/critical areas with community transmission, including private and public establishments, with concurrence of the RIATF;
 - c. Immediate facility-based isolation of all returning citizens, suspect, and probable cases;
 - d. Scaling up of local health system capacity, especially for community isolation and critical care, including dedicated mechanical ventilators, ICU, isolation, and ward beds for COVID-19 cases;
 - e. Submission of complete and accurate data through COVID-Kaya and DOH DataCollect.
- 5. The National Task Force and DILG shall ensure that areas flagged for local action shall implement strict lockdown of areas in line with the Zoning Containment Strategy, strict enforcement of minimum health standards, and intensified tracing and quarantine of close contacts and isolation of confirmed cases.



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RESOLVED FURTHER, the Chairperson and the Co-Chairperson shall be duly authorized to sign for and on behalf of the Inter-Agency Task Force.
