President Rodrigo Roa Duterte on the passing of Ambassador Dr. Sinyo Harry Sarundajang

The Philippines lost a true friend and a champion of Philippines-Indonesia bilateral relations with the sudden passing of His Excellency Dr. Sinyo Harry Sarundajang, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Indonesia to the Philippines.
