I thank Vaccine Czar Carlito Galvez Jr., the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases, the Department of Health, and the Department of Foreign Affairs and their institutional partners for securing a steady vaccine supply to the country.

I enjoin these agencies to ensure the safe and effective distribution and rollout of these vaccines, amidst the spread of COVID-19 variants.

As we continue to vaccinate our population, I urge you to keep observing our minimum public health standards even after you have been vaccinated.

Remember to wear masks, wash hands, observe social distancing and stay home whenever you can. We cannot afford to be complacent, especially with the presence of the Delta variant.

As President, I assure you that we are exerting all efforts and will continue to use all available resources to end this pandemic. Join us in our collaborative action in beating this pandemic through vaccination and the strict observance of health protocols.

With your support, I am certain that we will see better and brighter days ahead and emerge stronger as one nation.
