SPEECH OF PRESIDENT RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE DURING THE INAUGURATION OF THE BICOL INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

[Delivered in Daraga, Albay | 07 October 2021]

Kindly sit down. Thank you.

In bold letters nandito, "Mr. President, we are live on TV kaya huwag kang magmura." [laughter] This is not a place for epithets and making curses. Ano ito, pormal ito.

You know, in the hindsight, one of the things disappointed ang mga taga-Davao is because sinabi ko sa lahat sa Cabinet, the funds walang political alignments, walang political color. It will be distributed equally. But there was one caveat na sinabi ko kay Art, "Unahin ninyo ang ibang lugar, huwag ang Davao." So ang Davao kung napunta kayo, hindi makalahati sa ganda, and the space, crowded masyado.

Transportation Secretary Arthur Tugade; Senator Bong Go; Presidential Adviser for Bicol Affairs Marvel Clavecilla... Iyong mga kaibigan mong NPA, pakisabi nga sa kanila na they have been overtaken by modernization ng bayan. Iyong sinunog nila dito, it only shows their bankruptcy in the mind.
