#### Vaccination activities

- 84 LGUs\* cancelled their vaccination activities, majority of which are in Regions MIMAROPA, VI, VIII, and CARAGA
- All LGUs in other regions have 100% functional vaccination operations and have resumed Bayanihan, Bakunahan 2

#### Assessment of COVID-19 vaccine inventories

- Potential wastage of vaccines and damage of cold chain facilities are expected in severely hit areas
- 100 vials (600 doses) of Pfizer vaccine in Region VI can no longer be used

# PUBLIC ADVISORY ON INTERVAL OF PRIMARY SERIES AND BOOSTER

21 December 2021

Following the amended Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for COVID-19 vaccine boosters, the Department of Health (DOH) would like to inform the public that all adults (ages 18 and above) are now eligible to receive a single-dose booster of COVID-19 vaccine at least three months after the second dose of AstraZeneca, Moderna, Pfizer, Sinovac or Sputnik vaccine, or at least 2 months after Janssen effective 22 December 2021.

The Department also reiterates that booster doses are not yet recommended for ages 12-17 years old.








