Clarified the number of days of security personnel will be on duty.	As provided under item no. 7 (Schedule/Program of Services) of the Technical Specifications, <i>xxx</i> a. The Service Contractor shall provide the required personnel seven (7) days a week including holidays. (emphasis supplied) <i>b. The work shift, time schedule, numbers, and names of workers shall be agreed upon through internal arrangement between the PCO and Service Contractor. The Service Contractor shall observe the shifting and deployment schedule specified in item III of the Technical Specifications</i> <i>xxx</i>
Whether permits are required to be submitted with the bid (eligibility requirements).	End-user clarified that the applicable permits/licenses shall be submitted by the bidder declared as having the Lowest/Single Calculated Bid , as part of the Post-Qualification requirements. Please refer to the amended portion of the ITB below: ITB Clause Sec. 20.2 Within a non-extendible period of five (5) calendar days from receipt by the Bidder of the notice from the BAC that it submitted the Lowest Calculated Bid, the bidder shall submit the following:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">a. original/physical copies of the technical and legal documents, and financial documents submitted and subjected to preliminary examination during bid opening;b. latest income and business tax returns filed and paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment System (eFPS); and other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the Bidding Documents and Supplemental/Bid Bulletin.c. Submission of a valid permit/s, and licenses issued by Supervisory Office for Security and Investigation Agencies (PNP-SOSIA) in compliance with RA 11917¹ and RA 5487².
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Pursuant to Section 22.5 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, this Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued for the information and guidance of all prospective bidders and shall form an integral part of the Bidding Documents issued for said the project.
