SPEECH BY PRESIDENT FERDINAND R. MARCOS JR. AT THE 44TH COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE ACADEMY (PNPA) "MASIDTALAK" CLASS OF 2023 [Delivered at Camp General Mariano Castañeda in Silang, Cavite | 10 March 2023]
