AT THE BILATERAL MEETING BETWEEN THE PHILIPPINES AND JAPAN

[Delivered at the State Dining Room, Malacañan Palace in Manila | 29 April 2025]

Thank you for accepting my invitation to visit the Philippines.

It is my pleasure to see you in Manila after our very quick briefing in Laos last October on the sidelines of the ASEAN Summit.
