Anent to the scheduled Pre-Bid Conference to be held on **08 May 2025** for the above-cited procurement project by the Bids and Awards Committee, please be informed of the following clarifications made and the amendments on the Bidding Documents:

Amendments shall be highlighted in “red”

Clarification	Answer
Clarification whether the End User can extend delivery schedule up to 60 days	The EU shall retain the 45 calendar days delivery requirement, but the winning supplier may request for an extension subject to the approval of the HOPE.
Clarification whether the requirements for the High-End Laptop 13.3-inch can be amended	Please see the amended technical specification <i>(reminder: Sign and state “Comply” in both the original technical specification and the amended portion of the technical specification below)</i>



Section VII. Technical Specifications

Bidders must state “**Comply**” in the column “**Statement of Compliance**” against each of the individual parameters of each “Specifications.”

‘Bidders must state here either “Comply” or “Not Comply” against each of the individual parameters of each Specification stating the corresponding performance parameter of the equipment offered. Statements of “Comply” or “Not Comply” must be supported by evidence in a Bidders Bid and cross-referenced to that evidence. Evidence shall be in the form of manufacturer’s un-amended sales literature, unconditional statements of specification and compliance issued by the manufacturer, samples, independent test data etc., as appropriate. A statement that is not supported by evidence or is subsequently found to be contradicted by the evidence presented will render the Bid under evaluation liable for rejection. A statement either in the Bidders statement of compliance or the supporting evidence that is found to be false either during Bid evaluation, post-qualification or the execution of the Contract may be regarded as fraudulent and render the Bidder or supplier liable for prosecution subject to the provisions of ITB Clause 3.1(a)(ii) and/or GCC Clause 2.1(a)(ii).’
