6. Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by you or any of your duly authorized representative/s.
7. The item/s shall be delivered according to the requirements specified in the Technical Specifications.
8. The PCO shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods to confirm their conformity to the technical specifications.
9. Payment shall be made after delivery and upon the submission of the required supporting documents, i.e., Order Slip and/or Billing statement, by the supplier, contractor or consultant. Our Government Servicing Bank, i.e., the Land Bank of the Philippines, shall credit the amount due to the identified bank account of the supplier, contractor or consultant **not earlier than twenty-four (24) hours, but not later than forty-eight (48) hours**, upon receipt of our advice.
