- III. If the completed sample requires any changes, the winning bidder must submit the proposed revisions within 3 working days.
- IV. Once the finished sample delivered by the winning bidder is approved by the End-user unit, the winning bidder will have **30 calendar days** to produce and the required IEC collaterals.
